## Introduction

This is Somerset Council's submission setting out a proposed structure of electoral divisions for the local authority from 2027. In order to develop consensus to respond to the Commission's call for submissions, the Council established a cross-party working group to undertake a detailed evaluation and analysis of proposed options. The Working Group decided, due the limited time available to respond, to use existing polling districts as the foundational building blocks to develop a new scheme. In only one parish (Cheddar) was it necessary to split a polling district.

The Council had expressed the view that, wherever possible, its preference was for predominantly single member divisions to ensure that there was clear accountability for local communities, as set out in the Unitary Business Case. Additionally, the Council had decided that there was a requirement for 96 councillors. In devising a council wide pattern of electoral divisions, and following the detailed analytical work detailed below, the Working Group recommended that a 95 councillor scheme produced the most satisfactory outcome. This scheme allowed for 89 single member divisions and three two-member divisions (92 divisions in total). The two-member divisions were included because, in each case, the unity of the community would be better served by two members. The areas concerned were the City of Wells, the town of Minehead and the parish of Street.

The Working Group accepted that some compromises would be necessary to enable it to draw up a Council-wide scheme, and worked on a cross-party basis to achieve the most equitable and logical scheme, given the limitations of time.

The overall electorate of Somerset, based on the projected 2030 figures is 467,274; the original target figure for 96 divisions per single member division was 4,867, and the Working Group endeavoured with great success to stay within 10% of that figure.

Ultimately, with 95 members, the electorate per member equated to 4,918, which may have resulted in some divisions being slightly outside of the 10% tolerance originally sought.
