# What is a Statement of Community Involvement (SCI)?

- Local Authorities required to consult when preparing planning policy documents and determining applications
- Legal requirement for a Local Planning Authority to produce a SCI
- SCI should set out how the Local Planning Authority will engage and consult with the community and stakeholders on planning matters
- Covers both engagement on planning policy (e.g. Local Plan, Neighbourhood Plans) and determination of planning applications



### The need for a new SCI for Somerset

- Each of the existing 5 Local Planning Authorities (County and Districts) have their own separate SCI's
- There is therefore a need to prepare a new single SCI for Somerset
- Need consistent approach to how we engage with our communities on planning matters after vesting day
