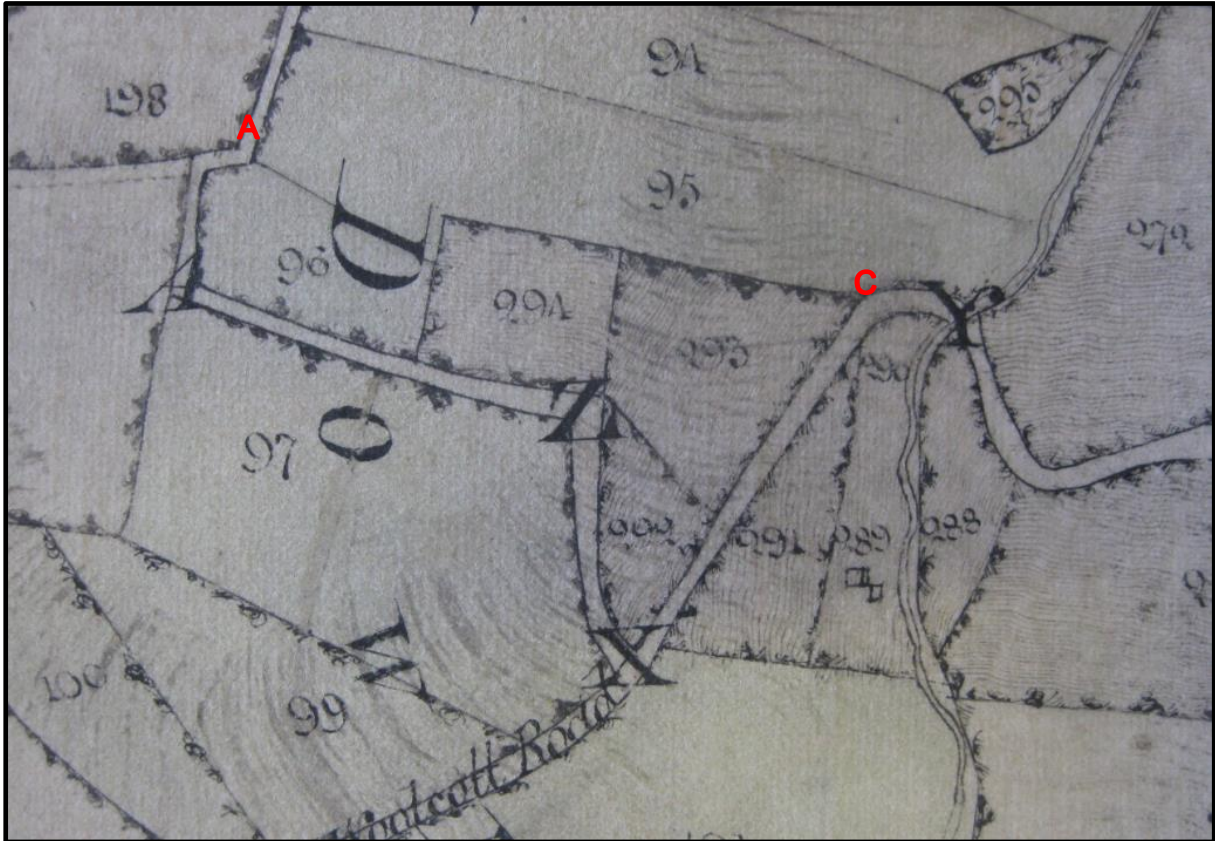
Transcript: ...and the said Commissioners shall and they are hereby also empowered and required to set out and appoint, and cause to be made, erected and completed, such public Bridle Roads and Footways, and private Roads and Ways, and also such Banks, Ditches, Drains, Watercourses, Bridges, Stiles and other Conveniences, in, over, and upon the Commons and Waste Lands hereby intended to be divided and allotted, as they shall think requisite.

...in that Behalf order, direct, and appoint; and that after the sever-
 al public and private Roads and Ways shall have been set out
 and appointed as aforesaid, it shall not be lawful for any Person
 or Persons to use any other Roads or Ways either public or pri-
 vate over or upon the said Commons and Waste Lands; and that
 all former Roads and Ways, or so much of them as shall not be
 set out and appointed by the said Commissioners as aforesaid,
 shall be deemed Part of the Commons and Waste Lands to be di-
 vided and inclosed by virtue of this Act.

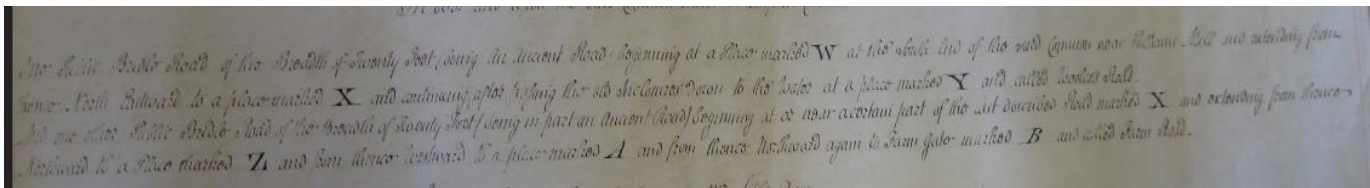
Transcript: ...after the said and several public and private Roads and Ways shall have been set out and appointed as aforesaid, it shall not be lawful for any Person or Persons to use any other Roads or Ways either public or private over or upon the said Commons and Waste Land; and that all former Roads and Ways, or so much of them as shall not be set out and appointed by the said Commissioners as aforesaid, shall be deemed part of the Commons and Waste lands to be divided and inclosed by virtue of this Act.

Farm Road: And one other Public Bridle Road of the Breadth of Twenty Foot [?] an ancient road beginning at or near a certain part of the last described Road marked X and extending from thence Northward to a Place marked Z and from thence Westward to a place marked A and from thence northward again to Farm Gate marked B and called Farm Road
