
Appendix 5. Chard Inclosure Act, 1815.

And be it further Enacted, That in cafe it shall appear to the Commissioners may alter faid Commissioners that there are or is any public Highways or Roads Highway, Bridle Roads or Bridle Road, Footways or Footway, or through Inclosures. other Road or Roads, Way or Ways, Path or Paths, in, through, over or upon any of the Lands directed to be inclosed, or other Lands within the faid Parifh, which may in their judgment be diverted or turned, without inconvenience to the Public, into any other public Highways or Highway, Bridle Roads or Bridle Road, Footways or Footway, or other Road or Roads, Way or Ways, Path or Paths, or be diverted or turned, fo as to make the fame more convenient to the Public, or be ftopped up and deftroyed as fuperfluous and unneceffary, it shall be lawful for them with the Concurrence and Order of Two Justices of the Peace acting in and for the faid County of Somerfet, not being interefted in the faid Inclofure,

Inclofure, and in the manner and fubject to Appeal as in this or the faid recited Act is mentioned, in and by their Award to order and direct fuch public Highways or Highway, Bridle Roads or Bridle Road, Footways or Footway, or other Road or Roads, Way or Ways, Path or Paths, to be altered, turned, ftopped or difcontinued, in fuch manner as the faid Juffices fhall think proper.
