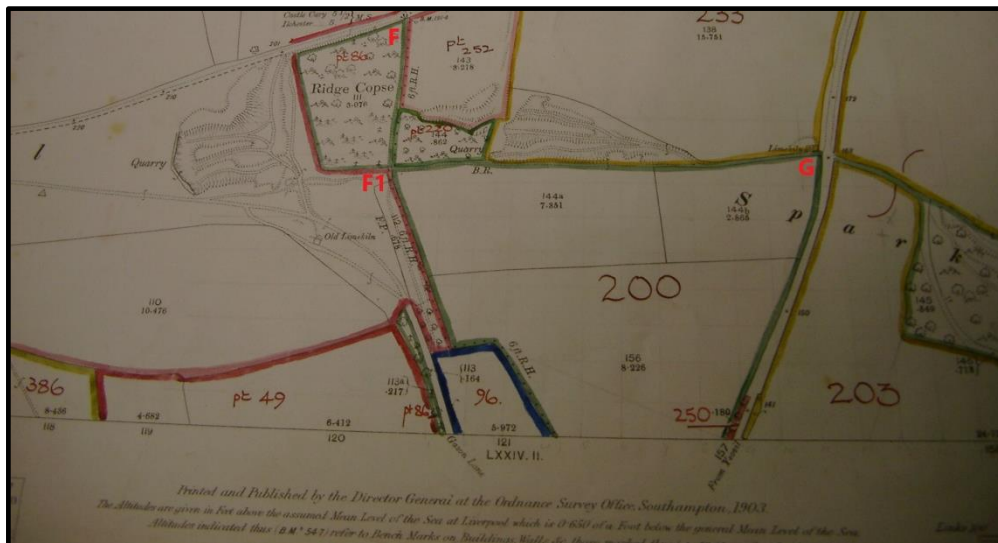


Map sheet 74-7 covering the application route with red letters F, F1 and G added to mark the route.

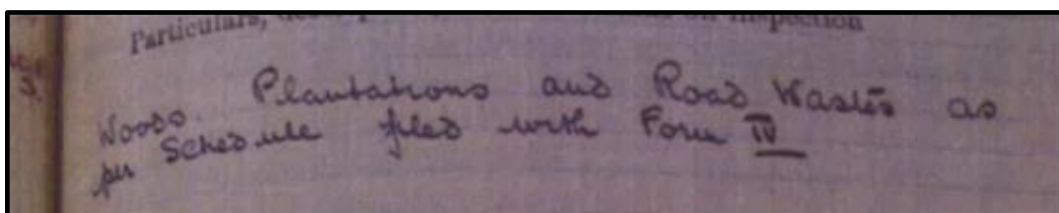
