		The Sub-Committee fully considered the application and the submissions of the Licensing Officer and the representations made by the applicant and all relevant information at the hearing.
		 The Committee was mindful that there is a requirement for applicants to be aware off all polices when applying for a Private Hire Drivers Licence and they took into account that the applicant had signed the application confirming that they had read the policy.
		 It is important for the Council to follow the environment strategy which actively encourages applicants to invest in vehicles which offer the best environmental standards.
		 The applicant was advised that each application is based on its own merits. The personal (including financial) circumstances of the applicant is not a material consideration in determining the application.
		 The applicant had not supplied any further evidence or sufficient reasons to satisfy the Sub-Committee that there are exceptional reasons to depart from the environment vehicle standards requirements of the policy.
