<p>A4</p>	<p>Objection Notice received in respect of application made for variation of a Premises License for White Hart Inn, 19-21 Sadler Street, Wells, Somerset, BA5 2RR</p>	<p>On the evidence before it, having considered all the circumstances and agreement between the Applicants and Other Persons, the Sub-Committee grants the application to vary the Premises Licence as applied for, with the additional conditions as agreed with the police and set out in Annex (8) of the papers.</p> <p>The sub-Committee further approves the removal of Condition 3 from Annex 2 of the Licence.</p> <p>The Sub-Committee advises the Other Persons that if they feel that noise is excessive their best option is to contact the Applicants, and that such procedures are used to keep channels of communication open. In addition the Other Persons are advised to report incidents to Environmental Protection as well as keeping records of any concerns.</p> <p>Parties are reminded that there are rights of appeal against this the Licensing Authority’s decision pursuant to Section 181 of and Schedule 5 to the Licensing Act 2003. An appeal must be made to the Magistrates’ Court and commenced within 21 days of notification of the Authority’s decision.</p> <p>All parties are reminded of the procedures contained within the Licensing Act 2003 relating to review of the premises licence.
