Item 1: Appointment of the Chair

## Item 2: Appointment of the Vice Chair

Councillor Bob Filmer proposed Kevin Bray from East Brent Parish Council as the Vice-Chair and this was seconded by Councillor Alistair Hendry, Mr Bray was duly appointed as the vote was unanimous.

## Item 3: Apologies for Absence

Apologies were given for Councillor Mark Healey.

## Item 4: Declarations of Interest

Councillor John Cook-Woodman declared an Other Registrable Interest as he was a member of the Devon and Somerset Fire and Rescue.

## Item 5: Public Question Time

There were no questions from the members of the public.

## Item 6: To determine the priorities and areas of focus for the Local Community Network for the next 12 months

Those present were asked to think about the priorities and areas of focus they wished to put forward for the next 12 months and then report back to the meeting one priority that they considered was the most important.

## The following were considered priorities:

- Highway Issues, especially in town centres; these included speeding and potholes
- Lack of public transport and therefore restricts access to leisure and medical facilities
- Building of new estates and lack of supporting infrastructure i.e. medical facilities
- Speeding, highways, planning, police and crime including lack of contact with police, parking
- Travellers and illegal encampments
- Fly tipping Abolish charges at recycling centres which would reduce fly tipping

- > Relationships with Police need to be built
- Children and Young people: safety of residents from gangs, county lines and vulnerable young people, activities needed

#### Other themes/areas of work were:

- > Anti-social behaviour: CCTV, social media, reporting
- Communication with local residents via digital ways not always the answer with planning and bus services
- Puriton/Woolavington in wrong LCN?
- Buy in from local residents and organisations education
  & 3<sup>rd</sup> sector
- Housing for elderly and young
- Talk to existing organisations that are already making a difference i.e Village Agents
- Reduction of services due to funding issues
- Highways & Drainage responsibility for roadside drainage, need active drainage section to assist
- Need to maintain rural bus services
- M5 junction congestion on roads leading & leaving the junctions especially J22
- Additional resources needed for Planning Enforcement to deal with unauthorised development
- Dog fouling additional dog wardens needed & more patrols at recreational areas
- > Outstanding repair works etc for public rights of way
- More youth support County youth Service now abolished
- Lack of visible police presence in rural areas
- Tourism investment in Burnham and tourist activities
- > Investment in care homes & medical facilities
- Green agenda communication between organisations and points of contact, need to involve residents
- Broadband
- Inward Investment schools, footpaths, roads, cycle paths , surgeries and shops – CIL payments?
