Rodney Stoke Parish Council objects to this application on the following basis:

The Parish Council do not object in principle, but strongly object to the proposed hours. It is inappropriate at a family campsite and the Council cannot see the need for the extreme hours proposed. The site is in a rural area where sound will carry, and there are close neighbours.

There are concerns that inappropriate events could be held at the site if the license proposed is granted.

The extent of the license would encourage traffic movements including at very late and very early hours, ~~which would be a concern on the poor access onto a derestricted road near a hazardous double bend.~~

The Parish Council found it difficult to respond to specific matters when there was no detail provided on the justification for the excessively long hours.
