Hi,

I am happy to discuss this.

The red wine you saw was there against my specific instructions.

I need to explain what you describe as a shop.

For 2 years now I have tried to build a community here.

On Sundays I allow the church to use the conservatory foc.

I provide, FOC, a room for the health visitors, dental, social services, 2 charities and the Bulgarians have over the last 2 years had the use of the room next to the conservatory to sell product to each other.

You may recall the Burger van as well? FOC and in the winter I sponsor hot food on Friday and saturday nights, I have never ever received a penny from these but the goodwill and 'control' of the site is I believe mostly down to these feelgood points that don't really cost me much.

I have never charged for the 'shop'room, it is solely for them, not ever survived long but randomly we see it used.

I have made it clear to the various shopkeepers that no cigarettes or alcohol to be sold.

What surprises me most is that red wine was there, I can only think it was cooking wine because they drink spirits, maybe cheap beer but wine ?

I have explained again that under no circumstances should ANY alcohol be sold.

If I'm correct, I could sell it from the normal bar but I choose not to for the reasons already discussed.

I believe Rees is going to reapply for a license by the escape rooms, if successful I think we might surrender the license as he would be able to serve our future clients. You may recall he said he did not sell to the Bulgarians but he has implied he would be happy to service HPC workers.

I am happy to discuss these points whenever, I really hope we can develop a relationship where we stay compliant and fulfil our responsibilities, as ever I will do my best and any help / advice is very, very gratefully received..

Thank you for your email and my response is as follows:-

- 1. The letter relates to your premises licence and the spelling of your name was taken from that. If it is incorrect you need to advise the Licensing Authority accordingly.
- 2. I apologise if the information I have been given is incorrect but you don't state which part? I have however, fully investigated the information available to me.
- 3. I refer to my email to you dated 15th November at 13:08 whereby I gave relevant advice and attached a copy of the plan of the licensed area which has not been adhered to. If you would like a further copy, of this correspondence, please let me know. My letter of yesterday is also advisory and clearly outlines what is wrong at the premises.
- 4. I spoke to you yesterday to discuss the matter and give further advice but you did not wish to listen.

as well as Tracey of course who used to visit very very regularly but will confirm we are well off her weekly appointment list!

We do of course see wpc Tracey Jones every Wednesday for the passport checks for immigration, I'm sure if anything was wrong she is more than capable of telling us.

She has advised us about posters, books, etc. She knows full well we haven't sold any alcohol in our " shop", if you want to call it that.

The "shop" that is 1m outside our red line, is this really the worst offence? A few bottles of wine that would never get sold to our current clientel in a month of Sundays, they are not red wine drinkers! Again, Tracey will confirm whiskey, maybe vodka, but red wine at £10, no chance!

From our first meeting you have appeared very personally involved, there feels like an agenda to remove our license, you keep asking me to surrender it, why?

I remain committed as I have done from day 1 in getting everything right and I, once again, ask for your advice and help in reaching this point.

Laburnum has been a successful hotel with alcohol sales for nearly 40 years and we hope to return to those days, we just need help.

I have been looking at our records and collating information from colleagues and Partner agencies and I am now attaching a letter fully outlining the facts relating to Laburnum House Hotel. This is our usual procedure for all premises where licensing issues are found. It is my role to advise and ensure that licensed premises within my area are compliant when issues are found.

I am in receipt of your DPS application and I have advised you today that we have representations to make which are outlined fully in the attached letter.
