QUARTERLY PERFORMANCE REPORT

Summary

The Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) publishes Quarterly Performance Reports in accordance with the Elected Local Policing Bodies (Specified Information) Order 2011 and Amending Order (2021), to enable the public to have the information they need to assess police performance in their local area. The Order requires PCCs to publish information relating to local performance against the Government's national priorities and to provide a narrative statement on the contribution of their force to achieving improvements against National Police and Crime Measures:

- Reduce Murder and Other Homicide
- Serious Violence
- Disrupt Drugs Supply and County Lines
- Reduce Neighbourhood Crime
- Tackle Cybercrime
- Improve Victim Satisfaction, with a Focus on Victims of Domestic Abuse
- Better Criminal Justice Outcomes for Rape Cases

Quarterly Performance reports are shared with the Police and Crime Panel to enable their role in supporting and scrutinising the PCC. The substantive report for this Quarter will be circulated to the Panel for publication as soon as practicable prior to the November meeting.
