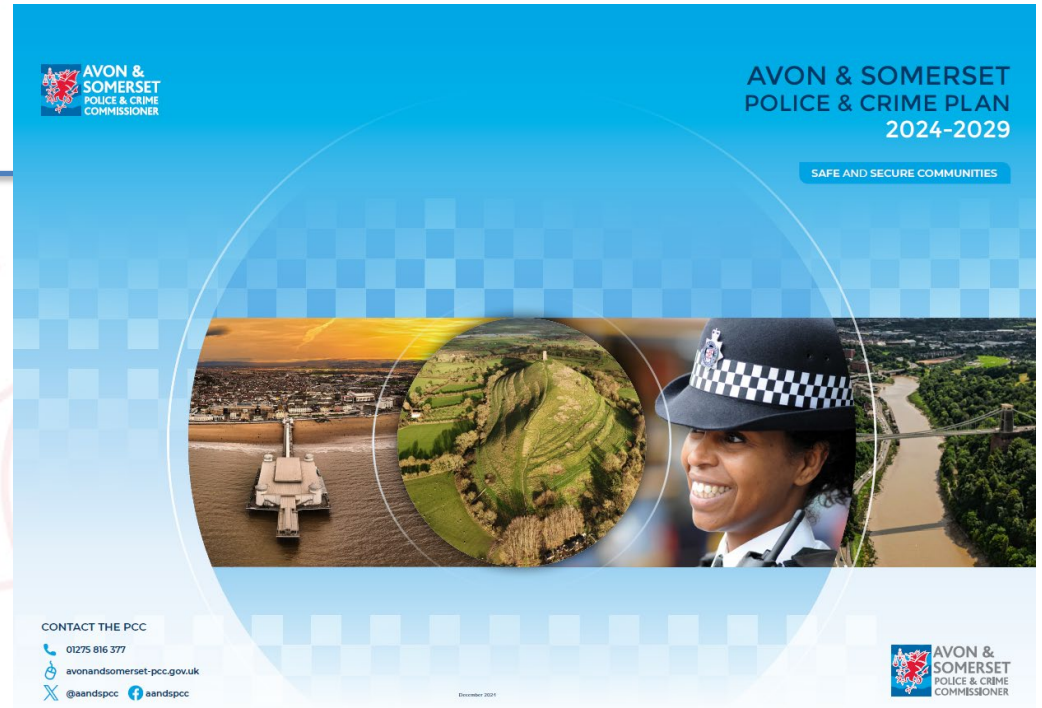

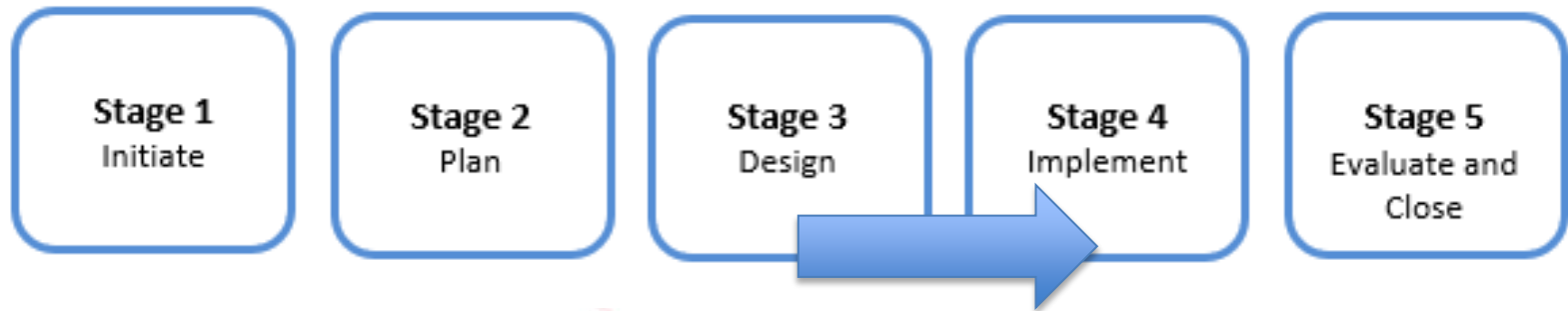

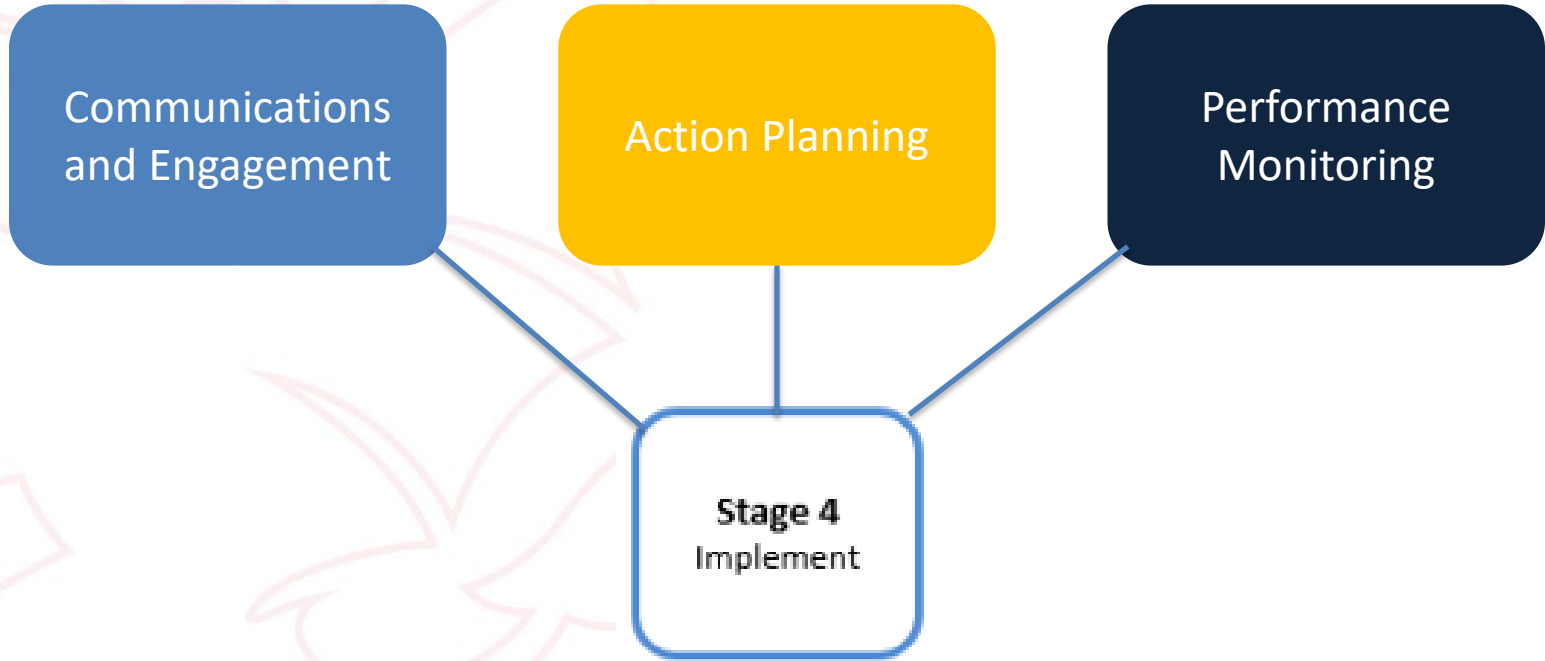

Stage 4: Implementation

Objective: To deliver an 'action plan' based on the outcomes of the consultation and in collaboration with the police and partners which will support the delivery of the 5 priorities in the Police and Crime Plan

- **Now :**
 - Assess activity collated through the consultation and align to OPCC, Police or Partners.
 - Comms Plan
 - Review action – what is possible and not? What is already in train? What is viable and achievable? What are the opportunities for quick wins?
 - Identify and engage key stakeholders in projected works for Q4 (working groups, OPCC, Police and Partner network meetings)
- **Jan-March 2025** – Assess activity and agree viable options to take forward.
- **March** – Map performance metrics and governance structures.
- **April** – Finalise and implement action plan
