IF WE ARE GRANTED THE VARIATION WHICH WE ARE REQUESTING, WHICH WILL ALLOW US TO MAKE SALES OF ALCOHOL FROM THE AREA REFERRED TO AS THE PADDOCK GARDEN, WE WILL CONTINUE TO MANAGE THIS AREA, AS WELL AS THE REST OF THE PREMISES IN SUCH A WAY THAT POINTS B → E ARE ALWAYS ADHERED TO

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

THIS IS SOMETHING WE ARE ALWAYS VIGILANT TO LOOK OUT FOR AND WE WOULD REFUSE SERVICE TO ANYBODY WHO IS NOT COMPLIANT WITH LICENCING RULES, WHICH THE PUBLIC HOUSE STRICTLY ADHERES TO. IF NECESSARY WE WOULD STOP SALE OF FOOD AND DRINK UNTIL SUCH TIME AS IT IS DEEMED SAFE TO RESUME.

c) Public safety

THE SAME POINTS AS IN POINT B APPLY. AS WE ARE CONSTANTLY MONITORING THE DAY TO DAY RUNNING OF THE PUBLIC HOUSE IF ANYTHING OCCURRED THAT WAS DEEMED TO PUT THE PUBLIC SAFETY AT RISK WE WOULD IMMEDIATELY PUT A STOP TO IT AND IF NECESSARY STOP ALL SALES AND SEEK ASSISTANCE FROM THE POLICE.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

AS WITH POINTS B AND C, WE ARE CONSTANTLY MONITORING THE DAY TO DAY OPERATION OF THE PUBLIC HOUSE. WE OPERATE THE CHALLENGE 21 SYSTEM AND ARE STRICT IN NOT ALLOWING THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL BY ANYONE UNDER THE AGE OF 18.

e) The protection of children from harm

AS WITH POINTS A → D, THE WELLBEING OF CHILDREN IS SOMETHING WE MONITOR CONSTANTLY. AS OUR ESTABLISHMENT IS MORE OF A DINING "RESTAURANT", CHILDREN ARE NOT AS READILY EXPOSED TO ACTIVITIES WHICH COULD PUT THEM AT RISK. WE ARE ALSO STRICT ON STICKING TO THE RULES WHICH DO NOT ALLOW UNDERAGE DRINKING. TO THE BEST OF MY KNOWLEDGE THERE IS NO DRUG USE ON OUR PREMISES EITHER.

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APPENDIX TO POINTS A → E

1. WE WILL HAVE A BOUND INCIDENT BOOK KEPT ON THE PREMISES IN WHICH WE WILL RECORD ANY INCIDENTS OF CRIME AND DISORDER. THIS WILL BE REVIEWED AND SIGNED BY MYSELF, THE PREMISES LICENCE HOLDER, OR BY THE PREMISES SUPERVISOR AS APPOINTED BY MYSELF IN MY ABSENCE. THIS BOOK WILL OF COURSE BE AVAILABLE AT ALL TIMES TO THE POLICE AND THE LICENCING AUTHORITY.
2. A CHALLENGE 25 PROOF OF AGE POLICY WILL BE ADOPTED AND IMPLEMENTED IN ALL AREAS OF THE PREMISES.
3. ALL PERSONS INVOLVED IN THE SALE OF ALCOHOL WILL RECEIVE TRAINING ON THE PREVENTION OF UNDERAGE SALES, AND REFUSAL OF SALES OF ALCOHOL TO ANYONE WHO APPEARS INTOXICATED. THE CHALLENGE 25 PROOF OF AGE POLICY WILL APPLY.
4. PERSONS HAVING RECEIVED THIS TRAINING WILL BE ASKED TO SIGN A FORM IN AGREEMENT.


